
## 1995 - 1998 Toyota 4runner (Hilux) Clock removal instructions 1. Check the dome-light. If the dome light is not working, check the dome light fuse, the light and clock are on the same circuit.



Remove the knobs and dials pulling straight out.
 Using a thin knife, spatula, or flathead screwdriver, carefully pry off the heat and AC face plate. The AC power button will pop as you gently move around the face plate.



- 4. Remove the 2 phillips head screws.
  5. Pull the center console from the dashboard, it helps gently pop a top comer and work your way around the console. The bottom portion will remain attached but you can access the clock at this point.
  6. Unplug all 3 wiring harnesses, hazard switch, rear defrost, and clock.
  7. With a thin bladed tool, gently pry the 4 tabs holding the clock in place.
